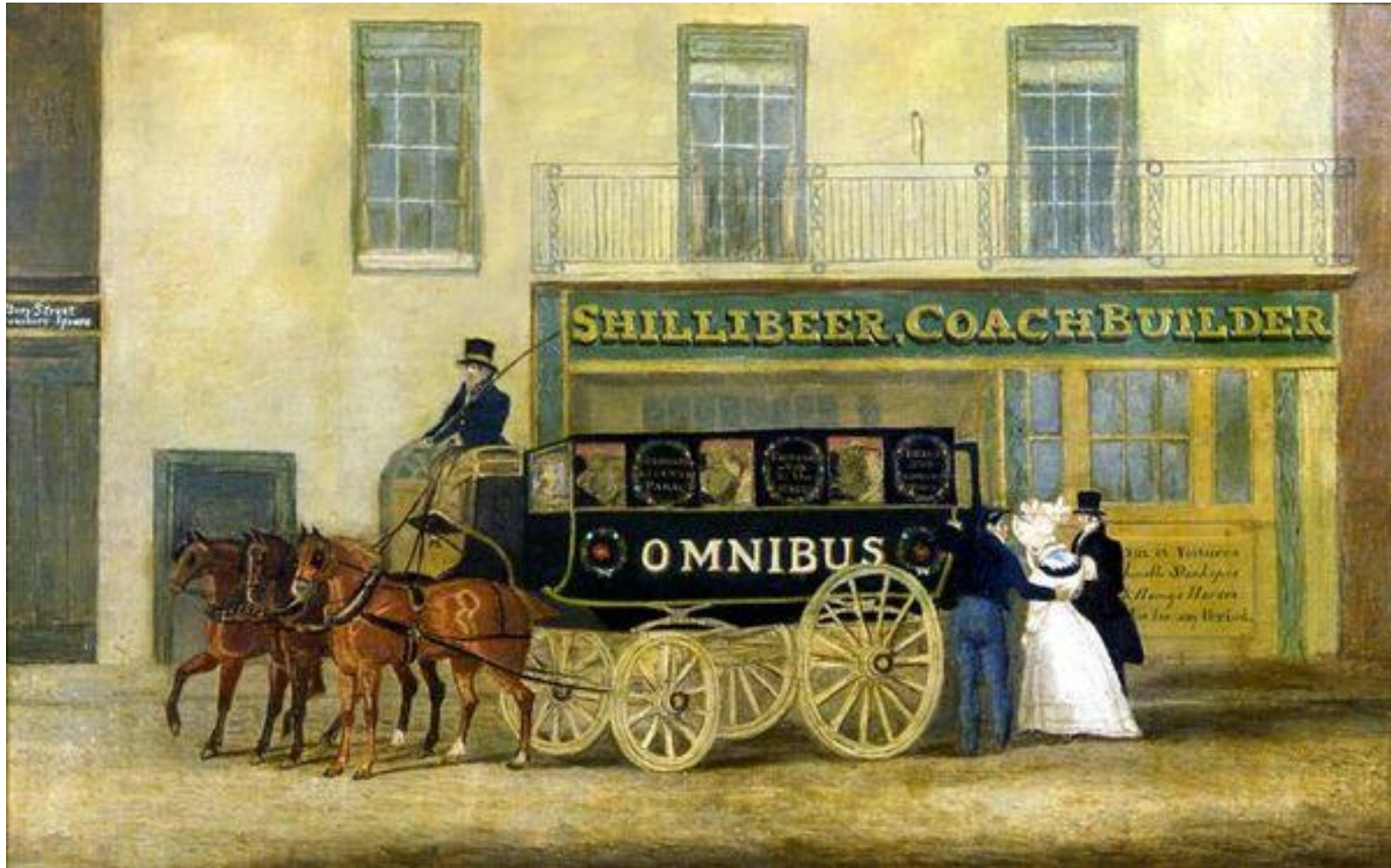


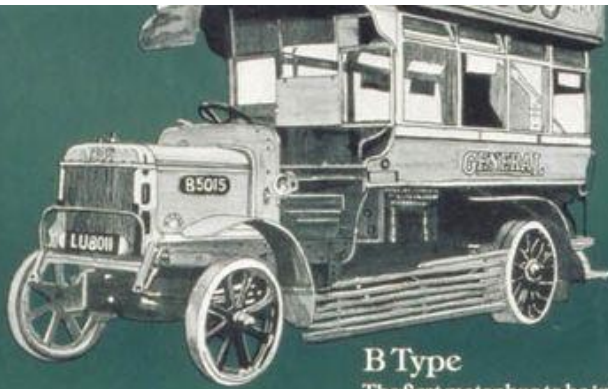

B Type

The first motor bus to be introduced in large quantities, over 2,900 were built from 1910 onwards, with many seeing service overseas carrying troops during the First World War.



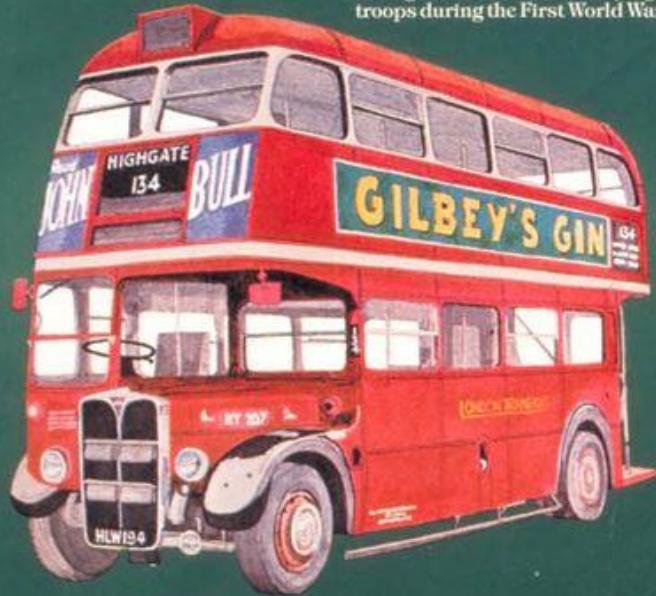
NS Type

Carried as many as 52 people. Many of these buses were rebuilt to carry a covered top and fitted with pneumatic tyres, one of the first buses in London to do so.



LT Type

Introduced in 1929, this six-wheeled A.E.C. bus carried up to 60 passengers in more comfort than ever before and at that time was the largest bus in London.
